OUR NEW SEASON

Ladies in Lavender by Shaun McKenna, directed by Alan Goss:

Two ageing spinsters find a young man, a virtuoso violinist who had fallen from a ship near death on a nearby beach sparking an infatuation that must remain unspoken. **September 22nd to 30th 2017.**

Hay Fever by Noel Coward, directed by Alistair Brown:

A classic comedy that is often described as a cross between high farce and a comedy of manners, centring on the outrageous behaviour of the eccentric members of the Bliss family. **November 17th to 25th 2017.**

Wendy and Peter Pan by Ella Hickson, directed by Angela Goss:

A magical version of JM Barrie's classic children's story, originally performed by the RSC. **January 19th to 27th 2018.**

The Memory of Water by Shelagh Stephenson, directed by Alan Clarke:

Three sisters reunite the day before their mother's funeral. The relationships between them and their own personal lives are laid bare, and the revelations are both tragic and comic. **March 9th to 17th 2018.**

Jane Eyre by Willis Hall, directed by Christine Rayment: Adapted from the Charlotte Bronte classic, the tormented life and redemption of a north-eastern girl is brought to life on stage: **May 11th to 19th 2018.**

Perfect Wedding by Robert Hawdon, directed by Adam Croft:

A bridegroom wakes on his wedding morning in his own bridal suite, with his bride-to-be about to arrive any moment, and finds a strange girl in bed beside him. **July 6th to 14th 2018.**
